The members of Hurricane Creek Grange have invited the Photo Club to set up a Photo Club Exhibit on Saturday and Sunday, October 23-24. They plan on having a "Soup Supper" on Saturday. At this time, the time each day is not firm, but Sunday time would be half a day - perhaps 1:00 to 4:00 PM.

There will be a need for people to help hang pictures before and take them down after the show.

Pictures should be framed, but uni-frames are acceptable. Pictures do not need to be new or solely in the county, so look into your "stash" in the closet. If you care to price and sell you may.

It may be that there will also be a call for pictures to be shown on a "continuous loop" with the projector, so cull your computer storage also.

**CALENDAR PREPARATION** - In the past, the Photo Club relied on Joan to prepare the photos for publication in the calendar, but last year, David Bridges did the prep for publication, with the assistance of Harold, who printed draft versions of the prepared photos prior to sending them to ColorPess for proof prints. This year, Harold and David hope for a procedure with greater participation from the original photographers. Here are the possibilities.

For anyone who wishes to prepare their own photos for publication, there will be a workshop this coming Saturday, February 13, 9:00 a.m. - 11:a.m. in the club room. I plan a practical, down-to-earth look at how color degrades in conversion to CMYK, followed by a review of the Photoshop tools that assist in getting the color back as good as possible after the conversion. You can reply to this email to let me know if you would like to participate in this workshop, or I will give you a phone call.

Later, when we have first prints of the CMYK versions of the selected photos, we need the original photographers, along with anyone else who is willing, to critique the prints. When this will happen is to be announced. Still later, a final review of the proofs from ColorPress will be our last chance to get the photos the way we want them to appear in the calendar.

Having as many of the original photographers and other club members deeply involved in the crucial preparation of our photos for publication will be the most important part of making the 2011 calendar as good as we want it to be. Participating in any way you can will be greatly appreciated.

**Photo Sharing:** Again this year, the club will be having its Photo Sharing events, usually suggested topic ahead of the event. Topics can range from a simple color, to various shapes, photographic techniques, focus, feelings/emotions, or any other topic that can be captured in a photograph.

Members are encouraged to be creative and to go out and shoot for the topic, rather than searching through existing photos to find something that matches. However, if you have a photo that works well for the topic, please share it with the members as well. Bring your photos on CD or thumb drive to be shown at the Photo Sharing events.

The Photo Sharing topic for March 2 is "Blue".
